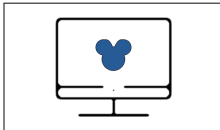


STENCIL VINYL

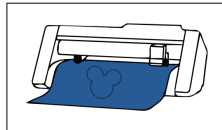
Introduction

Stencil vinyl is a special adhesive vinyl. It's translucently blue-dyed stencil film made of special PVC in 90 microns, glue, and PET, and it's compatible with most craft cutters. Stencil vinyl is for paint and spray techniques on even surfaces, such as vehicle lettering, stencil painting, promotional lettering, and exhibition decoration. Usually, it can be applied to wood, cloth, plastic, stone, glass, ceramics, etc.

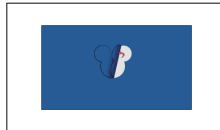
Instructions



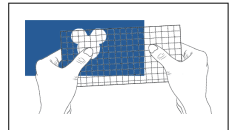
1. Create your design.



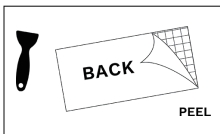
2. Cut the design on the cutting side of the vinyl.



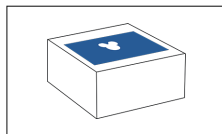
3. Weed the excess parts.



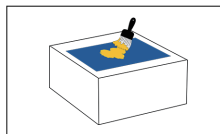
4. Apply transfer tape to the design and squeegee.



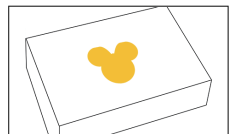
5. Peel off the protective film.



6. Apply the vinyl design to an even surface and peel off the transfer tape.



7. Brush paint on the vinyl design.



8. Once the paint is dry, peel off the stencil vinyl.

Blade: Standard
Setting: stencil vinyl
Pressure: Default

Silhouette Cameo

Blade: 3 Speed: 6
Force: 5 Passes: 2
Material: smooth

Attention

1. Cutting Side: Peel off from the corner of the stencil vinyl, and there are the blue vinyl and the protective film. The blue vinyl side is the cutting side.
2. Not suitable for wet objects and walls.
3. Do not mirror your design before cutting.
4. Do not add water to the paint.
